Wahoo State Bank Announces Officer Promotions, New Directors and Plans For Driveup Bank

Start of Press release Gregory R. Hohl, 37, has been named President of the Wahoo State Bank, Wahoo, Nebraska. He succeeds Robert J. Hohl who has been President for 20 years and who will continue to serve as Chairman of the Board. Gregory Hohl is a graduate of the University of Nebraska at Lincoln and the Colorado Graduate School of Banking. He began his banking career with the North Dallas Bank, Dallas, Texas in 1979 and has been with Wahoo State Bank for the past 11 years.

The Board of Directors have also appointed Cynthia K. Johannesen Senior Vice President and Cashier and Robert D. Couton, Jr., Vice President.

Janice A. Hohl and Gerard A. Divis have been elected to serve on the Board of Directors of Wahoo State Bank. They succeed the late John R. Hohl and Helen L. Divis who is retiring from the Board of Directors after 18 years of service as a Director.

Wahoo State Bank has purchased property located at the northwest corner of 5th and Chestnut in Wahoo for the purpose of building a driveup bank facility . The facility will contain three drive-thru lanes and a small lobby for walk-in customer traffic and is expected to provide greater convenience and service to the Bank's customers as well as the community. A beginning construction date has not been set and is dependent upon selection of the final design, contractors and regulatory approval.
