6 Days July 27 to August 1, 2026

Day 1 – Niagara Falls, ON – Dinner at Queen Victoria Place –

Today, depart from Omaha, NE on a flight to Toronto, ON. On arrival at the airport, a deluxe motorcoach will be waiting to transfer you to Niagara Falls, ON.

Check into the Marriott Niagara Falls Fallsview Hotel & Spa for a four-night stay. This hotel is situated just 100 yards from Niagara Falls, providing stunning views of the Horseshoe Falls and the American Falls. It's within walking distance of attractions like Fallsview Casino Resort, Niagara City Cruises, and the Niagara Parks.

Tonight, dinner is included this evening at the Queen Victoria Place offering spectacular panoramic views of the majestic falls and a mouthwatering, locally sourced dinner. (D)

Day 2 - Guide Niagara Falls Tour – Table Rock Market – Niagara Adventure Theatre – Free Evening –

After breakfast, meet your local guide for a tour of Niagara Falls. Stops will include Queen Victoria Park, Table Rock, the Whirlpool, Floral Clock and the upper river. Next, stop for lunch on your own at Table Rock Market. This all-new market features café and deli favorites, fresh sushi and more, located just steps from the Horseshoe Falls.

Get a glimpse into Niagara Falls' sensational true stories including the death-defying daredevils that attempted to challenge the roaring and treacherous waters. Enjoy a free evening exploring Niagara Falls. Dinner will be on your own this evening. (B)

Day 3 – Niagara-on-the-Lake – Free Time on Queen Street – Icewine Experience – Niagara Falls Illumination & Fireworks -

After breakfast, depart for Niagara on the Lake. Enjoy free time on Queen Street, in the heart of the town's historic district. It is filled with diverse shops, restaurants, and art galleries. Lunch will be on your own.

Next, visit Inniskillin Wines for an Icewine Experience. Explore the captivating history of their flagship wine, Icewine, and delve deeper into the art of Icewine production. Engage your senses in a unique and interactive tasting experience where you'll put your nose and taste buds to the test. Enjoy a sparkling Vidal Icewine upon arrival, plus sample three Icewines using different stemware, allowing you to fully appreciate the nuances and complexities of each. A seasonal dessert trio will be served with your Icewine as it pairs beautifully together.

Returning to Niagara Falls, dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. Tonight, enjoy the Niagara Falls Illumination Every evening, Niagara Falls is transformed into an incredible, multi-colored water and light masterpiece. There are also fireworks shows nightly at 10 PM during the summer months launched from the gorge between the American and Canadian Horseshoe Falls and set to a backdrop of the illuminated waterfalls. Day 4 - Niagara Parks Power Station – Voyage to the Falls Boat Tour –

After breakfast, enjoy a guided tour of Niagara Parks Power Station. This is the chance to discover the incredible history and heritage of this celebrated building. Dive into the history of the

visionaries behind it as well as the workers that kept it running for 100 years. Harnessing the powerful energy of the Horseshoe Falls, this pioneer of hydropower comes back to life with entertaining and educational experience that highlights both the remarkable history and unique architectural features of this 115-year-old engineering marvel.

Today, lunch is included at a local restaurant. This afternoon, enjoy the Voyage to the Falls Boat Tour. This cruise provides an up-close viewing of the magnificent Great Gorge, American Falls, Bridal Veil Falls and of course the mighty Horseshoe Falls. You'll experience the thundering roar, awesome power and amazing mist of Niagara Falls. Tonight, dinner will be included at a local restaurant. (B,L,D)

Day 5 – Niagara Falls, NY – Guided Tour - Lunch at Top of the Falls Restaurant – Cave of the Winds – Niagara Falls Observation Tower – Seneca Niagara Resort & Casino –

After breakfast, have your passports ready, as you will depart for the American-side of the Falls. Start the day by meeting your local guide for a sightseeing tour. Points of interest include Goat Island, Terrapin Point, Stedman Bluff, Niagara Reservation Park including Upper River Rapids and Crow's Nest along with Whirlpool State Park.

Lunch will be included today at the Top of the Falls Restaurant. When views were being handed out, Top of the Falls was first in line. The venue is found within Niagara Falls State Park on Goat Island, overlooking Terrapin Point. Featuring panoramic views through floor-to-ceiling windows and an outdoor dining deck, Top of the Falls is so much more than a meal.

Next, it's time for a thrilling walk on Niagara Falls' wild side. The spectacular Cave of the Winds Tour takes you into a stormy mist zone, where "soaking up the experience" takes on new meaning! Your journey begins with an elevator ride 175 feet down into Niagara Gorge. Geared up in a souvenir rain poncho and specially designed sandals, follow wooden walkways along Niagara River to the Hurricane Deck, just a few breathtaking feet from the torrents of Niagara Falls. Here, rushing Bridal Veil Falls creates tropical storm-like conditions. Talk about a rush! Nowhere else on Earth gets you closer to the Falls.

Then visit the Niagara Falls Observation Tower for the only panoramic view of all three cataracts that comprise Niagara Falls, including the American Falls. Elevators at the Observation Tower provide access to the base of the gorge and the boarding site for the Maid of the Mist boat tour. For a multi-sensory view of the American Falls, visitors can go to the base of the gorge and climb a series of stairs to the Crow's Nest, where the views come with complimentary air conditioning and blasts of misty Niagara spray.

End the day by checking into the Seneca Niagara Resort & Casino for the night. Enjoy deluxe rooms that provide easy access for those who dream of hitting a life-changing jackpot and feeling the mists of Bridal Veil Falls, all in one incredible getaway. While there, take a dip in the sparkling indoor pool. Enjoy the evening at the casino. Dinner will be on your own. (B, L)

Day 6 - Depart for Home –

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the Buffalo Niagara International Airport for your return flight home. (B)
